Dear Friends,

One of the scribes came to Jesus and asked him,
“Which is the first of all the commandments?”

Jesus replied, “the first is this: *Hear, O Israel! The Lord
our God is Lord alone! You shall love the Lord your God
with all your heart, with all you soul, with all your mind,
and with all your strength.*

The second is this: *You shall love your neighbor as
yourself.* There is no other commandment greater than
these. (Matthew 12: 28-31)

God's commandments and teachings are strong
guideposts that we should pay attention to, they are a
roadmap that helps us see if we are on the right path
to finding understanding God's will. However, the
ministry of Christ throughout the Gospels tells us that
approaching our faith as a checklist is not the goal.
God's commandments and decrees are meant to lead
us deeper into the compassionate, relational, and
merciful heart of God. If we are confused about which
way to turn, Jesus tells us that we need to go in the
direction of love. – real and embodied.
