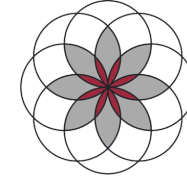


### Prayer for Spiritual Communion

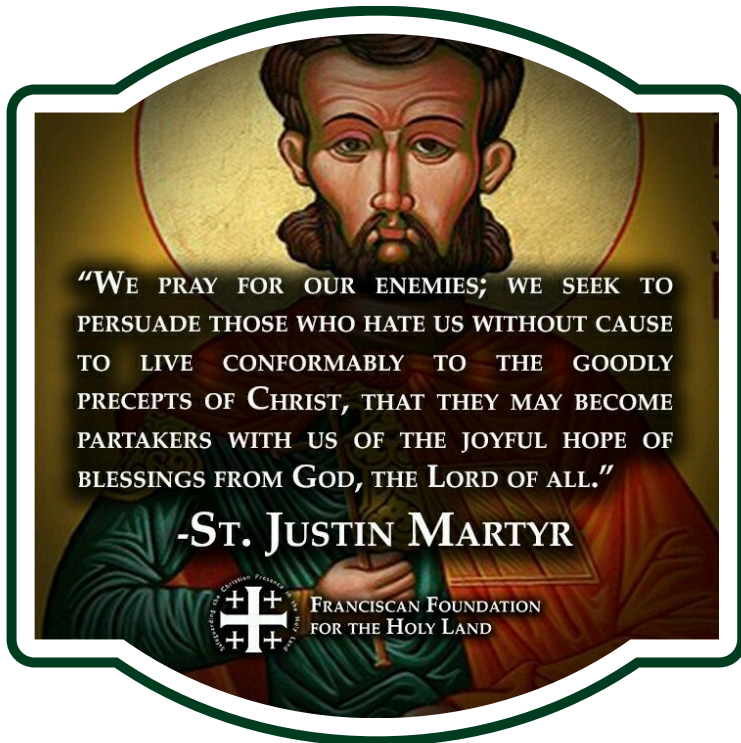

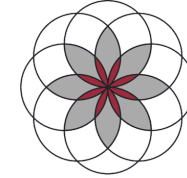
