Dear Friends,

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus challenges us to recognize the difference between what we want and what we need.

Whether or not we came from an elite background, have access to the best in education, or come from a community that has abundant resources makes no difference in the eyes of God. We are all one in Christ Jesus. We are on the road of the Christ-life only if we bear the marks of Christ’s suffering; abandoning pettiness and greed and turning always to compassion to those around us. Emptying our selfishness so that we might love one another is the only way to coast in Christ.

The world does not encourage us to maintain a peaceful posture; it assures us that “fighting” for our own self-interest is the only respectable thing to do. Yet Jesus assures us in the gospel that cultivating peace is within our horizon

We can practice calmness, to refuse to slip into shouting, and to de-escalate violence when we can. We can start by practicing peace within our hearts; then we must turn to the world.

Although the world tells us that we need many things to be happy, Jesus is telling us that all we need for the journey is his grace and the knowledge that we are doing his work.
