I embrace You and unite myself wholly to You.

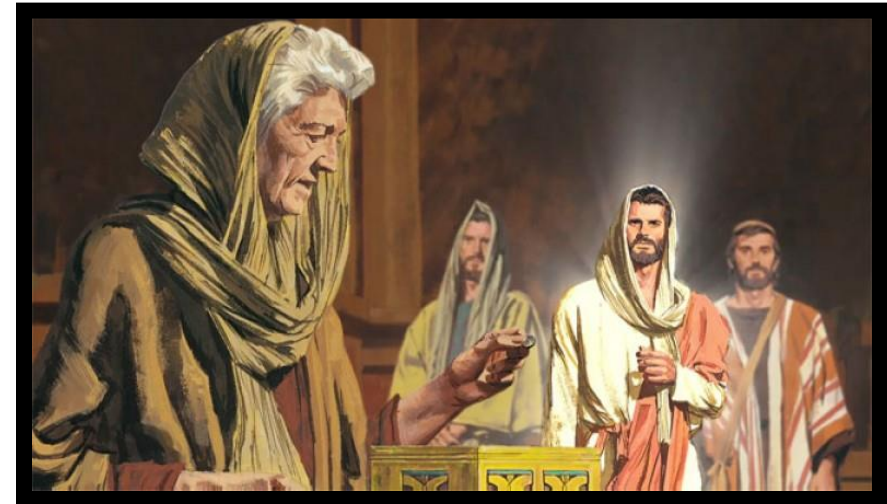
