Dear St Ann's Home Community,

We are sorry and saddened to report that a resident on the 9th floor at St Ann's Home died from complications of Covid-19 infection on 12/25/2021. Due to the nature of this person's illness it does not appear that other residents on the 9th floor had direct exposure. Thank you for keeping this person and their family in your prayers.

Also, a staff person who provides direct care and an elder on the first floor have tested positive for Covid-19. As you know, all team members are required to be vaccinated against Covid -19 per state and federal regulations.

Additionally, 2 staff members have tested positive for covid on 12/24/21. One of the staff members did not have any resident exposure however the other staff member did have high risk exposure with 14 residents. These residents have been placed on yellow precautions and their families have been notified. We will be testing them based on their consent on Monday and an additional day late next week. We hope everyone has a safe and happy holiday and will update you all next week.

The floors impacted have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected. Any other elders that had close contact with this team member or elder will be placed on yellow precautions and will be tested for the virus. Staff are actively monitoring all residents at St Ann's Home given the increase in Covid 19 cases in Monroe County. The staff of St Ann's will continue to do everything we can to keep your loved ones safe.
