Dear St Ann's Family member,

This letter will provide you with an update on COVID for the Portland skilled nursing campus. Overnight we have identified 6 staff members who have tested positive for the virus. 4 of these team members are part of the clinical team and two staff members are not clinical and had no significant contact with elders. We have identified that the infected clinical staff members worked on the SCU, LCC, 7<sup>th</sup> floor, and 4<sup>th</sup> floor. All team members are vaccinated. In addition we have had 9 elders that tested positive on the SCU for COVID and one elder on the 8<sup>th</sup> floor that tested positive. Families of elders that tested positive have been contacted and a plan has been reviewed with their families. As a result of this we have elected to do the following:

- All elders with COVID on the SCU will be moved temporarily to the south side of the unit to decrease transmission to those not infected.
- Elders that do not have COVID on the SCU will be temporarily relocated to the north side of the unit
- Ongoing testing of elders on the SCU
- Continued staff testing on the SCU
- All Elders on the LCC will be placed on yellow and have surveillance tests sent tomorrow 12/30/21
- 4 elders on the 7<sup>th</sup> floor will be placed on yellow and will have surveillance tests tomorrow
- 2 elders on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor will be placed on yellow and will have surveillance tests tomorrow

We are reminding you that visitation is still permissible but that visiting elders that have contracted the virus poses a personal risk. If you do choose to visit, please wear mask, shield and any other PPE required based on the "color" posted outside the elder's door. If you are unsure, please ask staff on the floor to instruct you on the proper PPE and how to put it on/take it off so that you are protected.

Finally, based on the current situation, we would like to invite you to a zoom call tomorrow at noon where we can summarize the situation and our plans as well as answer questions.
