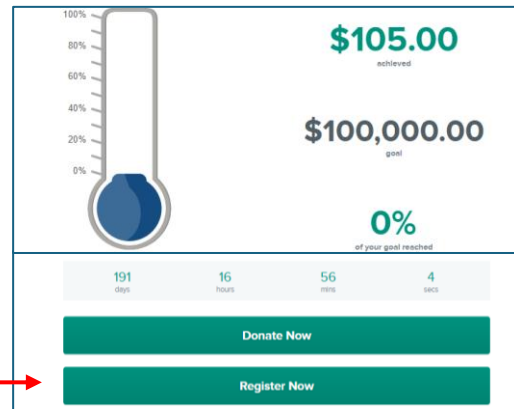


St. Ann's Community Walk 2026

Participant Registration Guide

If you fundraised and registered for last year's St. Ann's Community Walk, please follow this guide and you will be prompted to log in to your existing account at the end!

1. Click the 'Register Now' button under the thermometer.



2. Select how you'll be participating:

Walking & Fundraising - on Event Day or On Your Own!
Planning to join us on event day—or walking on your own if you can't attend? Register here. During registration, you'll also see an option to sign up for our NEW Putting Contest.

Commit to raising at least \$50 by 9.12.2026 12:01am EST or cover the difference.

Kids under 14
Kids under 14 are free to attend with an adult.

Elders & Family Members
Have a loved one that lives at St. Ann's Community? Register here to bring them to this event. During registration, you'll also see an option to sign up for our NEW Putting Contest.

Corporate Partner Walking Teams
Only use if walking as part of a company sponsorship. During registration, you'll also see an option to sign up for our NEW Putting Contest.

If you select 'Walking & Fundraising – on Event Day or On Your Own', go to the next step!

If you select 'Elders & Family Members', 'Kids under 14' or 'Corporate Partner Walking Teams', complete registration and you are all set!

Don't forget to register for our *new* Putting Contest!(Ages 14+)

3. Next, determine if you'll be participating **As an Individual** or if you want to **Join or Create a Team**. If participating **As an Individual**, select and advance to step 6.



Work on your own to reach your personal fundraising goal.


Join or Start a Team >

4. If you select **Join or Create a Team**, you'll see a pop-up asking you to **Join** an existing team or **Start A New Team**.





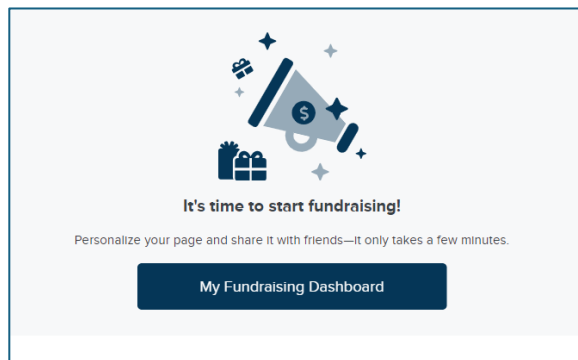
